Immediately after Mass today, I will be leaving for the week to be available for my father, whose heart procedure is tomorrow at Mayo Clinic Hospital and to spend some time with my family over the Thanksgiving break. I am truly grateful for all of you and the many kindnesses you have extended to me in my first three months in New England. Having arrived not knowing a soul or what to expect here, I have been made to feel most welcome and at home among you. Thank you especially for the several invitations to Thanksgiving dinners with your families that were extended. I hope to be able to join each of your families around your tables in the future.

Father Healey, the chaplain of Thomas More College in Nashua has graciously agreed to offer the Traditional Mass here at St. Stanislaus on a couple of days when he is available during my absence. Therefore, this coming week there will be no Mass on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, but there will be Mass on Thursday (Thanksgiving Day) at 9 a.m. and Friday at 7 a.m. Father has limited

mobility because of an injury and surgery, so those desiring to receive Holy Communion are asked to come all the way up to the top altar step and kneel there (or stand if you are unable to kneel) since Father will be unable to come down to the Communion Rail step. In addition, Father will hear confessions 30 minutes before Mass on those days but he will hear them in the sacristy next to the Blessed Mother altar. If the door is open, Father is available. Please enter through the door next to the Marian altar and kneel at the kneeler just inside the sacristy for Confession. I am grateful to Father for filling some gaps left in the schedule due to my absence.

A reminder that the Masses on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays will be at 8 a.m. starting November 28th. Finally, note that the **Altar Server Workshop** for all current and potential Altar Servers will be held on Saturday, December 3. We will begin with the parish Mass at 9 a.m. After this, I'll provide a light breakfast and then we will get to work with Low and High Mass training mixed in with some activities, lunch and ending at 2:30 p.m.

**Feast of the Immaculate Conception.** On Thursday, December 8, a Holyday of Obligation, two Masses will be offered at St. Stanislaus, Low Mass at 7 a.m. and High Mass at 7 p.m. Confessions will be heard before the Masses as usual.
