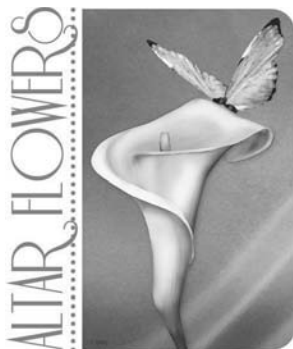
After soliciting feedback from the parish and receiving several comments, I have decided to move the Mass time on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays to 8:00 a.m. beginning on the first Monday of Advent, November 28th. I thank everyone for their input. It was almost unanimous that a change from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. was desired. The rest of the Mass schedule will remain the same: Tuesdays and Thursdays at Noon, Saturday at 9 a.m. and Sunday at 10 a.m.

I will have an **Altar Server Workshop** this Saturday, November 19 for all current and potential Altar Servers. We will begin with the parish Mass at 9 a.m. After this, I'll provide a light breakfast and then we will get to work with Low and High Mass training mixed in with some activities, lunch and ending at 2:30 p.m. We have Altar Servers coming from a variety of different parishes and chapels in addition to new servers, so this will be an extended opportunity to come together to practice how we will specifically do things at St. Stanislaus. I would ask a couple of fathers to volunteer to help me out that day so we can ensure the necessary "2-deep" leadership. Please rsvp on the website or send me and email to let me know if you will be able to make it.

Thank you for your prayers and sacrifices for the recent election. We now have a duty to continue to pray and sacrifice for the elected leaders that they might be guided by the Holy Ghost in so that God's Law would always be respected and honored in their leadership and decisions.

Parish Announcements

Remember to pray for the Holy Souls especially during the month of November. We are past the Octave of All Souls Day but there are still Partial Indulgences available for reciting the prayer "*Requiem aeternam dona eis, Domine, et lux perpetua luceat eis. Requiescant in pace. Amen.*" ("Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.") Partial Indulgences are also available for praying Lauds or Vespers of the Office of the Dead. All indulgences whatsoever may be applied to the Poor Souls at any time by way of suffrage. The simple intention to offer them for the Poor Souls is sufficient.



Envelopes are available in the back of Church for sponsoring flowers for the High Altar. A donation of \$40 would provide two vases of flowers for Sunday Mass and the following days. Flowers could be sponsored for a particular intention for the living, such as Anniversaries, birthdays, etc. or "In

Memory of" a deceased person. If you would like to sponsor flowers for a particular Sunday, write your intention and the requested date on the envelope and return it with your donation to the collection basket or the office. Donations of any amount are also gratefully accepted to help defray the cost of flowers on Sundays with no sponsor. Special envelopes for Christmas flowers will be available in the near future as well.

All contributions to the parish which were given by check or in an envelope with a name have been entered into the parish database and is available online for those who have registered. Please check your record for accuracy and contact our bookkeeper, Pat, at the parish office on Mondays if you find any discrepancies or have any questions. An acknowledgement of all contributions received will be sent in mid-January.

Although we are not ready to establish full parish office hours, there are a few regularities that can assist you when contacting the office:

- ♦ Pat Wixon, Parish Bookkeeper, is generally in the office Mondays from 9 a.m. until somewhere between Noon and 3 p.m., depending on the workload
- ♦ Father Brancich will generally be away from the office from Noon on Mondays until late Tuesday morning.

- ♦ Rose Smith is volunteering as a secretary and will mostly work afternoons on Tuesdays and Thursdays
